# PROCEDURE

FC file

### FC File Download

Download the file from BOSSWeb to your shop computer. This calibration file will update the ECM software.

NOTE: Use B.U.D.S. version 3.0.5.4.

Proceed as follows:

1. On the internet, go to the BOSSWeb site:

- 2. Under ComCenter drop down list, select:
  - DOCUMENT
- 3. In the menu, select:
  - Document Type: DIAGNOSTIC SOFTWARE
  - Category: B.U.D.S.
  - Product Line: ROADSTER

- 4. Click on arrow to start search and wait for result.
- 5. Select box and download the calibration update file:



**NOTE:** Remember where you save the file, because you will browse for it. If your internet connection is on another PC, you will want to download the file to CD ROM or other method of transfer, to update your shop computer.

### **Computer and Vehicle Preparation**

**NOTICE** Continuous power to the computer and to the vehicle is mandatory during this operation. Be sure to disable the computer screen saver. If using a portable computer, be sure to provide a continuous supply of electrical power by connecting it to a wall outlet. This software update of the vehicle modules will take some time to complete and MUST NOT be interrupted or damage to a module will occur.

- 1. Ensure you have B.U.D.S. version 3.0.5.4 available on BOSSWeb installed on your computer.
- 2. Ensure the vehicle battery is fully charged.
- 3. Connect a portable power pack, or a 2 amp battery charger to the vehicle battery to ensure there is enough power to complete the software updates.



PORTABLE POWER PACK OR A 2 AMP BATTERY CHARGER

**NOTE:** The update may take several minutes. If you are using a 2 amp battery charger and encounter communication problems during an update, your battery charger may be producing excessive electrical noise and a battery pack will need to be used. Some battery chargers are electrically "noisier" than others.

- 4. Connect all communication tools before starting B.U.D.S. to ensure proper operation. Refer to 2008-2009 SHOP MANUAL - SPYDER<sup>™</sup> GS for details:
  - Section 03: ELECTRONIC MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS
  - Subsection 02: COMMUNICATION TOOLS AND B.U.D.S. SOFTWARE



### **ECM Software Update**

**NOTICE** Avoid any interruption during the update. Disable the PC screen saver and use also a power outlet for the PC.

1. Turn ignition key to ON.



2. Start B.U.D.S. (3.0.5.4 version) and logon.

**NOTE:** The following message will be displayed in B.U.D.S. If it does not disappear automatically, click on the button "Try active detection mode".
